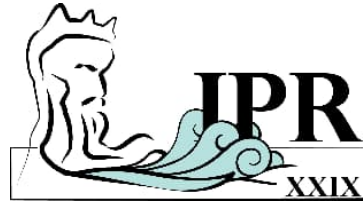

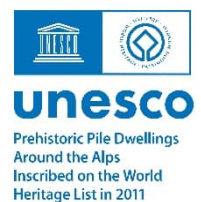

The “Museum im Schloss” in Arbon hosts the largest regional history exhibition in the Swiss canton Thurgau with a focus on 5500 years of settlement history in the Lake Constance region.

The field trip then takes you to the archaeological sites of a historic ship landing place called Stellinen and the “Hügeli” near Kesswil.

On the way back you will visit the “Seemuseum in Kreuzlingen” with a large exhibition of the local seafaring past and fishery history on Lake Constance.

Field Trip to Konstanz and Hemmenhofen: “Archäologisches Landesmuseum Baden-Württemberg (Archeological State Museum of Baden-Württemberg)” in Konstanz and “Landesamt für Denkmalpflege (State Office for Cultural Heritage) Baden-Württemberg, office” in Hemmenhofen.

The Archeological State Museum of Baden-Württemberg in Konstanz hosts a wide range of archeological finds from Baden-Württemberg with a focus on the UNESCO World Heritage “Prehistoric Pile Dwellings around the Alps” and the shipping on Lake Constance.
